आपको एक क्लियर फाइल में अपना असाइनमेंट जमा करना है – जिसमें रोज के ऑब्जरवेशन को इंग्लिश में ऑब्जरवेशन शीट में लिखना है।

जैसे आपको अगर किसी ऐतिहासिक स्थल (Historical Place) को ऑब्जरव करके लिखना है तो आप कुछ ऐसा लिख सकते हैं –

I visited a historical monument during my holidays. The building was made of old stones and had beautiful carvings.

(मैंने छुट्टियों में एक ऐतिहासिक स्मारक देखा। वह पुरानी पत्थरों से बना था और उस पर सुंदर नक्काशी थी।)

Many tourists were visiting the place and guides were explaining its history.

(कई पर्यटक उस जगह पर घूम रहे थे और गाइड उसका इतिहास बता रहे थे।)

I learned that such monuments help us understand our culture and history.

(मैंने सीखा कि ऐसे स्मारक हमें अपनी संस्कृति और इतिहास को समझने में मदद करते हैं।)

हर दिन के ऑब्जरवेशन को डेट डाल कर लिखना है।

असाइनमेंट में कुछ थिंकिंग वाले सवाल दिए गए हैं – जिन्हें सोच कर इंग्लिश में लिखना है।

3. Tourism from such places supports the economy.

Tasks

- Observe public places around your locality.
- Find out functions of hospital, police station, bank, railway station, and post office.
- Make a labelled map of your area.
- Write how government services help people.

Thinking Question

“Why are public services necessary for society?”

❖ DAY 2 – Agriculture, Environment & Sustainability

Tasks

- Compare different soil samples and write observations.
- Find out major crops grown in Bihar and India.
- Observe farming methods or irrigation systems.
- Write ways to protect environment and natural resources.

Thinking Question

“How can humans balance development and environmental protection?”

❖ DAY 3 – Human Body, Health & Nutrition

Tasks

- Prepare a balanced weekly diet chart.
- Observe your physical activities for 3 days.
- Research functions of major body systems.
- Write effects of unhealthy lifestyle and junk food.

Thinking Question

“Why is prevention better than cure?”

❖ DAY 4 – Water, Climate & Natural Resources

Tasks

- Observe weather changes for 5 days and make a report.
- Write methods of water conservation.
- Perform a simple experiment on evaporation or condensation.
- Find out causes of water scarcity.

Thinking Question

“What challenges may future generations face due to climate change?”

❖ DAY 5 – Biodiversity, Food Chain & Wildlife

Tasks

- Observe birds, insects, or animals around you.
- Draw a food chain and food web diagram.
- Research one endangered species and write about it.
- Find out importance of biodiversity in ecosystem.

Thinking Question

“What may happen if biodiversity decreases rapidly?”

❖ DAY 6 – Time, Ancient Civilizations & Inventions

Tasks

- Research how ancient civilizations measured time.
- Observe shadows during different times of the day.
- Write about one important invention that changed human history.
- Prepare a productive daily timetable.

Thinking Question

“How do inventions influence the progress of civilization?”

❖ DAY 7 – Household Budget, Banking & Financial Planning

Tasks

- Discuss household expenses with parents.
- Prepare a detailed monthly household budget.
- Differentiate between needs, wants, and luxury expenses.
- Find out how banks help people save money.

Thinking Question

“Why is financial planning important for every family?”

❖ DAY 8 – Technology, Communication & Cyber Safety

Tasks

- Compare traditional and modern communication systems.
- Observe traffic and safety rules in your area.
- Write advantages and disadvantages of internet and social media.
- Prepare a cyber safety awareness poster.

Thinking Question

“How has technology changed human behaviour and learning?”

❖ DAY 9 – Space Science, Earth & Scientific Exploration

Tasks

- Draw and label the solar system.
- Observe moon phases for two nights.
- Research satellites, ISRO, or space missions.
- Write interesting facts about planets and galaxies.

Thinking Question

“What would happen if humans could not explore space?”

❖ DAY 10 – Reflection, Creativity & Future Goals

Tasks

Write or draw:

- “What was my biggest learning during holidays?”
- “Which activity improved my thinking ability the most?”
- “What new habit or skill did I develop?”
- Make one “My Summer Achievement Page.”

Thinking Question

“Why should learning continue throughout life?”

• Business Budget Assignment

You have ₹5,00,000 to start a grocery shop. Prepare a proper business budget showing how the money will be used to set up and run the shop.

Instructions

Divide ₹5,00,000 into different categories such as:

- Shop rent
- Furniture and shelves
- Grocery items and stock
- Refrigerator/freezer
- Electricity and water connection
- Staff salary
- Transportation
- Advertising and signboard
- Emergency savings

Speaking Activity (Daily Basis)

“Ask Why” (Make a WHY Sheet)

Every day child writes ONE “WHY” question.

Examples:

- Why do earthquakes occur?
- Why do humans dream?
- Why does pollution increase global warming?
- Why do countries need laws and constitutions?
