आपको एक क्लियर फाइल में अपना असाइनमेंट जमा करना है – जिसमें रोज के ऑब्जरवेशन को इंग्लिश में ऑब्जरवेशन शीट में लिखना है।

जैसे आपको अगर किसी रेलवे स्टेशन (Railway Station) को ऑब्जरव करके लिखना है तो आप कुछ ऐसा लिख सकते हैं –

I visited a railway station near my city. Many trains were arriving and leaving the station. (मैंने अपने शहर के पास एक रेलवे स्टेशन देखा। वहाँ कई ट्रेनें आ-जा रही थीं।)

People were standing in queues and waiting for their trains. (लोग लाइन में खड़े होकर अपनी ट्रेनों का इंतजार कर रहे थे।)

I observed ticket counters, security guards, food stalls, and announcements. (मैंने टिकट काउंटर, सुरक्षा गार्ड, खाने की दुकानें और घोषणाएँ देखीं।)

हर दिन के ऑब्जरवेशन को डेट डाल कर लिखना है।

असाइनमेंट में कुछ थिंकिंग वाले सवाल दिए गए हैं – जिन्हें सोच कर इंग्लिश में लिखना है।

जैसे अगर यह सवाल हो:

Why is discipline important in public places?
(सार्वजनिक स्थानों पर अनुशासन क्यों जरूरी है?)

1. Discipline keeps places organized and safe.
2. It helps people work together peacefully.
3. Without discipline, confusion and accidents may happen.

Tasks

- Observe important public places around your locality.
- Visit or observe places like hospital, railway station, post office, bank, or market.
- Write their importance in society.
- Draw a labelled map of your locality.

Thinking Question

“Why do societies need public services?”

❖ DAY 2 – Agriculture, Soil & Environment Study

Tasks

- Compare different types of soil.
- Find out major crops grown in Bihar and India.
- Observe farming tools or methods used by farmers.
- Write ways to protect environment.

Thinking Question

“How does agriculture support human life?”

❖ DAY 3 – Health, Food & Human Body

Tasks

- Prepare a weekly healthy diet chart.
- Observe daily physical activities and exercise.
- Find out functions of major body organs.
- Write harmful effects of junk food.

Thinking Question

“Why should people maintain a healthy lifestyle?”

❖ DAY 4 – Water, Weather & Natural Resources

Tasks

- Observe weather changes for 5 days.
- Make a chart on uses of water.
- Write methods of water conservation.
- Observe how sunlight dries clothes and water evaporates.

Thinking Question

“What problems may arise due to shortage of natural resources?”

❖ DAY 5 – Animals, Food Chain & Biodiversity

Tasks

- Observe animals and birds around you.
- Prepare a food chain and food web diagram.
- Write 10 facts about an endangered animal.
- Find out importance of biodiversity.

Thinking Question

“What may happen if some animals disappear from Earth?”

❖ DAY 6 – Time, History & Ancient Inventions

Tasks

- Find out how ancient people measured time.
- Observe shadow changes during the day.
- Research one ancient invention and write about it.
- Prepare a personal study timetable.

Thinking Question

“How do inventions change human civilization?”

❖ DAY 7 – Household Budget & Financial Planning

Tasks

- Discuss monthly expenses with parents.
- Prepare a household budget chart.
- Observe needs and luxury expenses separately.
- Find out importance of saving money.

Thinking Question

“Why should families plan their expenses carefully?”

❖ DAY 8 – Technology, Communication & Safety

Tasks

- Compare old and modern communication methods.
- Observe traffic rules and road safety measures.
- Write advantages and disadvantages of mobile phones and internet.
- Make a safety awareness poster.

Thinking Question

“How has technology changed education and communication?”

❖ DAY 9 – Space, Earth & Scientific Discoveries

Tasks

- Draw and label the solar system.
- Observe moon phases for two nights.
- Find out about satellites and space missions.
- Write interesting facts about Earth and planets.

Thinking Question

“What would happen if there was no gravity on Earth?”

❖ DAY 10 – Reflection & Creative Learning

Tasks

Write or draw:

- “What was my biggest learning during holidays?”
- “Which activity improved my thinking the most?”
- “What new skill did I develop?”
- Make one “My Holiday Achievement Page.”

Household Budget Assignment

You have ₹50,000 to manage household expenses for one month. Prepare a proper household budget and use the money wisely.

Instructions

Prepare a monthly household budget by dividing ₹50,000 into different categories such as:

- Food and groceries
- Electricity bill
- Water bill
- School expenses
- Clothes
- Transport
- Medicines
- Internet and mobile recharge
- Savings
- Emergency expenses
- Charity or social help

Also calculate:

1. Total amount spent
2. Amount spent on each category
3. Which category had the highest expense
4. Which category had the lowest expense
5. How much money was saved
6. Which expenses were necessary and which were luxury expenses
7. Why proper financial planning is important

Make the chart neat and colorful.

Speaking Activity (Daily Basis)

“Ask Why” (Make a WHY Sheet)

Every day child writes ONE “WHY” question.

Examples:

- Why do volcanoes erupt?
- Why do humans need sleep?
- Why do planets move around the Sun?
- Why should we save electricity?

Child speaks for 2–3 minutes on:

1. Myself (Self Introduction)
2. My Favourite Freedom Fighter
3. Importance of Science in Daily Life
4. My Favourite Book or Story
5. My Holiday Learning
